Heads Up	Proposed National Code changes seeks feedback
Details	<p>Each year, the National Research Council (NRC) releases a set of proposed Building, Fire and Plumbing Code changes for comment which may be incorporated into the 2020 National Codes.</p> <p>Alberta has committed to adopt the National Codes without public review. This means comments on items that will be adopted in Alberta need to be made to the NRC through this national review process.</p> <p>This national public review ends January 2, 2018.</p>
Next Steps	<p>Individuals or organizations can comment on the changes.</p> <p>BILD Alberta will be assembling teams to review the proposed code items to provide comments to the NRC in coordination with CHBA National.</p>
